SEACOR ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES MIDDLE EAST TO PROVIDE CONSULTANCY SERVICES FOR ABU DHABI CRUDE OIL PIPELINE (ADCOP) PROJECT

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE – Abu Dhabi based SEACOR Environmental Services Middle East (SESME) the regional operating arm of SEACOR Environmental Services (SES), a global leader in risk management, environmental and emergency response solutions, has been contracted by China Petroleum Engineering Construction Company (CPECC) to develop and deliver All-Hazards Emergency Response Plans and Corporate Crisis Management Plans for the new Abu Dhabi Crude Oil Pipeline (ADCOP) project.

The ADCOP Project will involve the construction of a new 370 kilometre crude oil pipeline from Habshan in the Emirate of Abu Dhabi to the Emirate of Fujairah on the UAE east coast. Along with the pipeline are a number of pump stations and a large tank farm and marine terminal for loading VLCCs.

The project is being funded by the Abu Dhabi Government owned International Petroleum Investment Company (IPIC) with the intention of constructing a major storage and loading facility that connects the UAEs largest onshore oil fields operated by Abu Dhabi Company for Onshore Operations (ADCO) with a facility that will bypass the Straits of Hormuz. The pipeline will have an export capacity of up to 1.5 million barrels per day (mbpd), more than half of the UAE's estimated 2.8 mbpd production capacity.

SESME has been engaged to develop fire prevention & response, security, medical and oil spill plans for the various stages of the pipeline and associated infrastructure. There will also be a Crisis Management Plan for the operating company in the event of a major incident involving significant public, property or environmental damage.
